



40 Days In The Word Prayer Calendar



February 19—Pray that the Master’s Word will simply take off and race through the country to a ground swell of response, just as it did among you. 2 Thessalonians 3:1

February 20— Pray for Pastor St. Clair and Pastor Bob, that they will hear from the Holy Spirit as they continue to guide us through this journey.

February 21—Pray that people will accept Christ, be baptized, join our church family, and participate in a small group or Bible study.

February 22— Pray that this campaign will help make us one church, united for one purpose, to glorify God.

February 23—Pray that we will submit our hearts to God, that we will ask for our hearts to be cleansed, will confess and repent of our sins, and allow every part of our hearts to be touched and changed by God so that He and He alone will be glorified.

February 24—Pray that we share our faith and develop a heart for world missions.

February 28—Pray this scripture . . . Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing songs, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. Colossians 3:16

February 29—I pray that I will open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in Your law. Psalm 119:18

March 1—I pray that we do not merely listen to the Word and deceive ourselves; do what it says. James 1:22

March 2—Pray this: I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You. Psalm 119:11

March 3—Pray this . . . Therefore everyone that hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on a rock. Help us to be wise men. Matthew 7:24

March 4—Pray this . . . Your Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path. Psalm 119:105

March 6—Pray that TTUMC would be passionate about worship.

March 7—Pray that God will graciously bless our Small Groups and create a bond of friendship to develop lasting relationships to His glory and honor.

March 8—Pray that men, women, and children of our church will more completely understand they are created for God’s pleasure. Pray that they will have a joyful heart of worship and be best friends of the Lord. Mark 1:35

March 9—Pray for those whose hearts will be touched by God to accept Christ as their Savior and for those who will joining our church family. March 13—Pray this . . . I call on You, O God, for You will answer me, give ear to me, and hear my prayer. Psalm 17:6

March 14—Pray this . . . Now, my God, may Your eyes be open and Your ears attentive to prayers offered in this place. 2 Chronicles 6:40

March 15—Pray this Scripture: For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. Colossians 1:9

March 16—Pray this . . . Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went off to a solitary place where He prayed. Help us to find a quiet place and time to pray. Mark 1:35

March 17—Pray this . . . The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective. Help us to pray fervently for lost souls. James 5:16

March 18—Pray this . . . And may these words of mine, which I have prayed before the Lord, be near to the Lord our God day and night, that He may uphold the cause of His servant and the cause of His people Israel (and our church) according to each day's need. 1 Kings 8:59

March 19—Pray for Pastor St. Clair and Pastor Bob, that they will continue to hear from the Holy Spirit as they continue to guide us through this journey.

March 20—Pray that the Micah 6:8 project will impact people in Small Groups and the people of our community.

March 21-- Pray that we will commit to the habits of spiritual growth, including memorizing a weekly Bible verse and having daily devotions.
